
DEPRIVATION SCORE IN EACH ELECTORAL DISTRICT IN DUBLIN NORTH*

Deprivation Score: This measures the households that are considered to be marginalised or deprived because they cannot afford goods and services which are considered to be the norm for other people in society. A lower score means higher levels of deprivation. The identification of these households is based on a set of 11 basic deprivation indicators.
